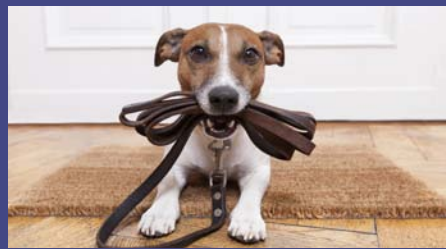
Dr Joram Mudzingwa

ADVANCED SURGERIES

Cruciate Ligament Surgery

Pets owners will benefit from having advanced surgery to stabilise their pets ruptured anterior cruciate ligament.



Patients undergoing a Triple Tibial Osteotomy (TTO) or a Tibial Plateau Levelling Osteotomy (TPLO) surgery generally have a quicker return to exercise, better overall function and a favourable long term prognosis. Advanced surgeries involve correcting the alignment of the tibial plateau so the forces within the joint are stabilised. An advanced surgery offers the best chance of your dog being able to chase a ball again.



Pet owners need to be vigilant in breeds prone to cruciate rupture, we recommend seeking Veterinary advice at the first signs of hindlimb lameness.

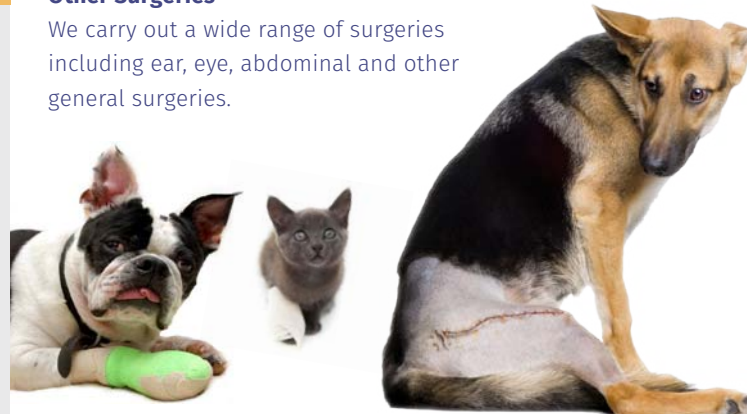
Fracture repairs

ROUTINE SURGERIES



The Advanced Surgery Centre offers routine surgeries which will be carried out by Dr Stephen or Dr Joram. Only the premium package for routine surgery will be offered in the Advanced Surgery Centre.

This package includes admission for surgery by an Advanced Surgery Centre nurse, a comprehensive blood screen prior to surgery and all other components will be similar to the high standard you have come to expect from Baldivis Vet Hospital.

Dog Speys

We recommend that all bitches who are not intended for breeding are spayed at 6 months of age. Large breeds are 8 months.

Cat Speys

We recommend that all females who are not intended for breeding are spayed at 4 to 6 months of age.

Dog Castration

We recommend that all dogs who are not intended for breeding are castrated at 6 months of age.

Cat Castrations

We recommend that all males who are not intended for breeding are castrated at 6 months of age.
